Abstracts requirements:

The volume of reports must not exceed 4 pages, A5 format, utilized text editor - Word for Windows, type – Times New Roman, book orientation, alignment – the width, 10 pt., 1.0 intervals, and 0.6 cm indentation, all fields – 2 cm.

Pictures should be in the . jpg format. Photos must be made with good black-and-white negatives, extremely clear with a resolution of at least 300 dpi. References are marked by an ordinal number, for example [1].

Plan of the paper: UDC, author's name, affiliation, title of article (no more than 70 symbols), abstract in English and Russian languages (up to 500 symbols each), key words (5-10), the main text of articles, bibliography (GOST 7.05-2008). **Structure of the text**: a problem statement, a summary of objectives, study methods and obtained results, conclusions.

Deadlines: 20.05 - acceptance of applications, 20.06 - reception of articles, 20.09 - publishing materials.

Conditions. The authors are solely responsible for the accuracy of the information and formatting the text. Reports should be submitted to the conference by authors or their representatives. Failure to comply with the requirements to the abstracts, the terms and conditions of participation, the organizing committee reserves the right not to accept them for publication.
